

JEFF'S TRUTH STATEMENTS

Any truth statements that start with a quote, like #4, "I love her more than you do," are revelations God spoke to me specifically and personally. They are not directly from Scripture, but they are rooted in Scripture. God will never give you a "Truth" that is not corroborated by His Word! I then take those "words from God" and make them into a truth statement I can say over my life.

1. I will silence the lies of the enemy and all who oppose God and His children by speaking the Truth of God's strength over my life. Psalm 8:2

4. "I love her more than you do." = God loves Sabrina more than I do, I surrender her to You, God.
5. God loves my kids more than I do. So, I will rise-up and take responsibility as a father, offering my best to the children God has entrusted me with. I will seek God's counsel for them, surrender my control of them, and stand on God's commitment to them.
6. "I love Element more than you do." = God loves Element more than I do. Numbers 27:16-17, 1 Chronicles 12:38
7. "You're worth it." = I'm worth it! Luke 12:6-7
8. I am worth Jesus to God. A King came to rescue me. (Louie Giglio sermon 1-31-21)
9. Any harm that has been done to me is overcome by the love God has for me.
10. There is sin on my record, but my record has been blotted out by the blood of Jesus Christ.
11. If God says I can, I can. What God says I have, I have.

12. I am on an essential assignment from God, both in my home and in His.
13. I am not the sum of my wins and losses, or defined by my best or my worst; I'm a loved son of the Most High God.

144. My God is still in control and still He reigns on His throne. Though mountains may tremble and sea billows roll, I say "It is well with my soul!" My God is still in control. (9-18-21) From "Still In Control" by Mack Brock

145. I'm not perfect, so sometimes, I will let people down. What matters is being obedient to God. I will obey God. (9-18-21) Galatians 1:10 (Sabrina shared from Devo: Strong, Brave, Loved by Holly Gerth - Day 3)

146. I fight from a place of victory through Christ's death on the cross and His resurrection. The victory is already won but there are battles that still remain. God gives the land but we have to fight to enter it. So, I will be strong in the Lord, suit up with all the armor of God, and stand firm to the very end. (9-19-21) Ephesians 6:10-13 My sermon called "Battles"

147. I don't know how God makes a way, but I know He will. He's been good on every promise, from Eden to Zion, from Element to the new land. Through every dead end and out of that grave. I don't know how He makes a way, but I know He will. (9-20-21)

148. My God is the God over all I know and don't know. He's in control of everything I know and don't know. I can trust Him. He is trustworthy. I believe it, I receive it, my God is over all! (9-20-21) Song "Over All I Know"

149. Jesus, has put the enemy under my feet. I take my position of authority over his strategies to derail me from my glorious future in Christ, and I praise and thank You Lord that all Your promises in Christ are "Yes" and "Amen". As I follow You, You will make me the head and not the tail, always on top and not on bottom. 150. I will rise-up and take responsibility for the authority God has given me in my marriage. I will make Jesus my first pursuit, and submission my first priority. I will seek, serve, and spoil my wife, leading and loving her with the same love that Jesus has shown me. Ephesians 5:21-25

151. Sabrina and I are united in Christ, unstoppable with Christ, and unbreakable because of Christ. So, we will live out our lives together, in intimacy, living in freedom, to pursue our dreams, growing everyday, and elevating the standard.
